Information

The Buck's Marsh Boardwalk Trail opened in February 2022. This trail takes visitors to Buck's Marsh where visitors can experience the marsh on a 120 foot long boardwalk extending halfway across the wetland. The trail provides exceptional scenic viewing, a way to explore the diversity of habitats the Refuge has to offer, plus opportunities for observing birds and other wildlife.

The Buck's Marsh Boardwalk Trail is approximately three quarters of a mile long to the boardwalk and is through rolling and sometimes moderately steep terrain. Most of the trail is graveled, but some portions are soil/grass.

The parking lot for the trail is located northeast of Oakland City at the east end of Base Road (CR 00) on Patoka River National Wildlife Refuge (see map).
